Eligible Work:

This is a non-juried show, open to all CWA members. All works will be accepted and exhibited, representing the best of Connecticut Women Artists. The exhibit will be hung salon-style to allow for multiple pieces per artist.

Media Categories:

All original work will be accepted including but not limited to painting, illustration, sculpture, printmaking, photography, mixed media, metal work, jewelry, graphics, glass, fiber, drawing, digital art and ceramics.
Photomechanical reproductions of original work (giclee prints, etc.) are not eligible.

All work must be ready to hang. Jewelry should be displayed in an enclosed case or frame. Artists may provide their own pedestals. There are a limited number of pedestals available for rental (\$5 each) from Gallery Director Tao LaBossiere.

Submissions:

All members are invited to submit up to three pieces. Sculpture size is limited to what will fit through the door. Large scale two-dimensional works may not exceed 4'x6'. Only one large work per artist will be accepted; maximum size for the remaining two entries should not to exceed 20 x 30" each.

Entry Fee:

A \$10.00 non-refundable fee is requested for each entry submitted, with a maximum of three entries per artist. Triptychs should be submitted as three individual pieces.

Sale of Artwork:

All sales will be through the participating artist and purchaser. CWA will not take a commission on any works sold and will not negotiate sales on behalf of the artists. *Artists may elect to voluntarily designate a portion of their sales as an additional donation to My Sister's Place.*
